Owners and crew of visiting participating boats are invited as guests of Kingston Yacht Club during the event.

INTRODUCTION

The 2021 Easter Seals Regatta and Pageant will include a handicap race for sailing boats, followed by a sailpast of Kingston Yacht Club of all boats of all types, including motorboats and boats that are paddled and rowed.

SAILPAST

Boats are asked to participate in a sailpast of Kingston Yacht Club following the race. After the racing finish signal is sounded, boats are required to either:

- A. If the <u>wind is westerly or southerly</u> then boats are asked to pass to the west of mark R and then past Kingston Yacht Club breakwall, to the north of mark P
- B. If the <u>wind is easterly or northerly</u> then boats are asked to pass to the north of mark S and then past Kingston Yacht Club breakwall, to the north of mark P.

2 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 2.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the KYC breakwall flagpole.
- 2.2 At the end of the racing and the beginning of the sailpast, The RC will sound a signal and hoist flag Zulu..

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Sailboat racing starts at 1130 and ends at 1300.
- 3.2 The sailpast commences immediately and ends at 1330.

3.3 The onshore awards ceremony and BBQ begins at 1400.
