Measurement

Fill out the "505 NAs Measurement Form" as much as possible before on-site registration. The form is available on the regatta page at https://kingstonyachtclub.ca/regattas. New sails will be measured at KYC on Wednesday, August 20. We will not be weighing all boats, but weights will be inspected if measurement certificates indicate added weight. A scale will be on site for spot checks. As indicated in the NOR, each boat can register one (1) boom, one (1) mast, one (1) centerboard, one (1) rudder and two (2) suits of sails.

Vehicle Parking

The KYC parking lot is for members only. There is parking on the streets by KYC with no restrictions on Saturday and Sunday, but with no-parking periods on weekdays. NAs participants can get a Temporary Parking Permit that would allow parking all day on Maitland and Simcoe streets and King Street on the south edge of the park. The cost is \$22.13 for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, tax included. There will be 25 permits available. You can pay with cash, etransfer or credit card at the regatta registration desk. We will need your car plate number and state/province. Please note that the permit does not guarantee a dedicated parking space, only the ability to park in available spaces.
