

# **KYC Sail to Amherst Island Sunday June 13 2015**

**N 44° 11.532' W 076° 39.306'**

Judith and Robert Mackenzie invite the Saturday Sail Cruisers to their place on Amherst Island on June 13.

It is about a two hour sail from KYC so a 10 o'clock departure will get you there about noon hour. The plan is to raft at their mooring or anchor nearby and proceed ashore. There is no dock so bring your dinghy if you have one. Bring your own lunch. We will offer wine, cold beer, plates and cutlery.

## **How To Get There by Boat**

Our place is on the north shore of Amherst Island located on the North Channel west of The Brothers Islands and east of Preston Cove which is located just east of Griffin Point. With reference to the chart proceed west past The Brothers Islands to the

point marked "X" on the chart. The coordinates of Point "X" are **N 44° 11.532' W 076° 39.306'**.

Point "X" lies just west of County Road 6 as extended southward from the mainland across the North Channel. The location of Point "X" is at the intersection of the Lennox power plant sight line and a range located in front of the house which is yellow with a brown steel roof. Point "X" is slightly beyond (west) of the house. The range is marked with two red triangles which also lines up with the steel chimney on the roof of the house. Binoculars are required to see the two red triangles from point

"X". Proceed towards the shore on the range. It is essential to keep dead on the range and not to wander off. Keep watch and proceed slowly.

Alternatively passage can be made between the centre and westerly Brother Islands and then proceeding to Point "X". Keep north of the shallower water off Amherst Island by keeping the entire Lennox power plant (not just the two stacks) in sight. The sight line is shown on the chart. westerly Brother Islands. When proceeding to Point "X" stay north of the shallow water off Amherst Island by keeping the entire Lennox

power plant (not just the two stacks) in sight. The sight line is shown on the chart.

Monitor Channel 71.

### **How To Get There by By Car**

The Amherst Island ferry departs hourly from Millhaven on the half hour. Departures from the Island are on the hour. \$9 return for a vehicle. Bicycles \$1.50. People free. If travelling by car consider doubling up and save a fare. On arrival on the island proceed straight ahead to the fourway stop intersection and turn left onto Front Road. Proceed through the hamlet of Stella and go about 4 km. Our place is at 1150 Front Road. Please note that a smaller Glenora ferry is currently operating.
